Due to the drought conditions that are forecasted to continue through 2012, we have organized for only hardy, drought tolerant trees to be planted along the banks of Little Cypress Creek.

Bur Oak - Large shade tree that can withstand prolonged drought

Cedar Elm - tough and adaptable tree with excellent drought tolerance

Wax Myrtle - drought tolerant shrub that is an important winterfood for many bird species
